Achievements: We have, with the guidance and help of Bro. Carl Shye, developed a formula and plan to raise one million dollars for the headquarters and mission.

Next Steps: Bishop Robert Douglas introduced us to Pastor Horace Miles of Phoenix, AZ, who has a company that developed a system for the California Council to monitor and provide instructions for each Diocese in collection the assessment monies - once this is approved by the Board and General Body.

Final Step: Have Pastor Miles fly to Chicago, or a place designated by the Presiding Bishop to explain the formula and process that would be necessary to implement the financial strategies as set forth by this committee.
